Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 293 amends sections of statute providing for five (5) Public Service Commission districts by adding language to allow for seven (7) districts after the effective date of legislation drawing seven districts as reflected in maps adopted by reference in section 75-101.01.

The Public Service Commission (PSC) estimates \$350,995 in fiscal year 2022 and ongoing costs of \$271,181 beginning in fiscal year 2023. This funding would pay for the new Commissioner's salaries, benefits, rent, and travel costs as well as the cost to remodel the current space to allow for the additional offices needed. There is no basis to disagree with these estimates.

LB 293 *allows* for two additional PSC districts but does not does not, in and of itself, call for this expansion. The bill's language simply allows for them after language drawing seven districts is enacted. For this reason, LB 293 has no fiscal impact at this time.
