LB 299 would allow the Game and Parks Commission to collect a permit issuance fee; raises the maximum permit issuance fee from \$1 to \$2; allows the Commission to issue multi-year permits at a reduced rate; eliminates the lower limit of several permit fees; removes the minimum age for hunting wild turkeys; creates a lifetime migratory waterfowl stamp; eliminates the nonrefundable application fee for a paddlefish permit and replaces it with a permit fee of up to \$35; and renames the Nongame and Endangered Species Conservation Fund the Wildlife Conservation Fund.

The estimated impact on cash fund revenues as estimated by the Commission are summarized as follows.
