Upon entering a classroom, students will place any personal electronic device(s) & accessory into a storage compartment. While in the storage compartment, the personal electronic device & accessory will be turned off, placed on "do not disturb" mode, or otherwise configured to not make noise, vibrate, or flash lights. While in a classroom, a student cannot possess or use such personal electronic device or accessory.

A student may possess or use their personal electronic device & accessory in a classroom:

- In the case of an emergency or when the student reasonably perceives an imminent threat of an emergency or harm to any
 person
- When a teacher grants permission for purposes of assisting in educational classroom activities or assignments
- When the student has a note from a health care provider stating that possession or use is necessary for the student's health or well-being
- With written permission from a principal, the principal's designee, or a school counselor

Enforcement of the provisions of this bill will be left up to the school district & school.
