Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB777 amends §79-1312, §79-1313, and §79-1316 to require the Nebraska Educational Telecommunications Commission (NETC) to develop and maintain a digital archive of the video coverage of the Nebraska Legislature.

The new digital archive will be accessible, indexed, and a digital Internet archive of the video coverage of the Nebraska Legislature, including all floor debate and public committee hearings, beginning with coverage of the 108th Legislature in January of 2023. All previous applicable historical video coverage of the Nebraska Legislature will be collected and added to the archive as available. NETC can determine and utilize the best formatting and file management methods for the archive.

The new archive will not be considered an official record of the proceedings and is intended solely for educational and informational purposes and to enhance access for the public in keeping with the Legislature's commitment to transparency in state government. Nothing in the Nebraska Educational Telecommunications Act will be construed to require NETC to post or distribute any work in a manner that would constitute a violation of federal copyright law.

EXPENDITURES

LB777 states that NETC should utilize funds available to them through the federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and it is assumed that General Funds would be utilized if ARPA funds are not available to use.

NETC does not believe that it is feasible for them to have the archive completed and ready until January of 2024 and would need to start with coverage of the 109th Legislature.

NETC will need to add an additional FTE to maintain and oversee the archive. For FY2022-23, the salary and benefits are \$120,000, with operating expenses of \$70,000. For FY2023-24, the salary and benefits increase by 2.5% to \$123,000, with operating expenses increasing by 2.86% to \$72,000.

NETC received three responses to their RFP & are using the highest of the three for this estimate. The estimate of expenses are \$550,000 to procure and implement for FY2022-23 and then the following costs to maintain the archive for the next five years through 2028:

- \$380,000 FY2023-24
- \$485,000 FY2024-25
- \$440,000 FY2025-26
- \$560,000 FY2026-27
- \$510,000 FY2027-28

The Legislative Council estimates no fiscal impact but has concerns about future fiscal impact if the Executive Board of the Nebraska Legislature determines that the videos produced by NETC are owned by the Legislature. Ownership rights, storage, and closed-captioning could present significant fiscal issues.
