Explanation of Estimate:

The bill would increase the maximum allowable per diem payments that could be paid to the Power Review Board member serving as Nebraska's representative on the Southwest Power Pool's Regional State Committee. The aggregate total of the representative's per diems and his or her proxies would also need to be increased by \$15,000, but that is only due to the underlying \$15,000 for the representative's per diems. Therefore, the total potential fiscal impact is limited to \$15,000.
