LB925 creates the Resilient Soils and Water Quality Act. (1) initiate first steps to accelerate the use and scope of best practices for healthy soil management, (2) protect and improve soil and water quality throughout the state, (3) protect the public's health and enhance agricultural production and profitability, (4) address soil health economics, resource stewardship, and managerial and environmental issues, (5) increase awareness, education, and promotion of healthy soil best practices through producer-to-producer, peer-to-peer, and mentoring relationships, networking, and sharing of technical information, and (6) provide observational proof of healthy soil benefits through access to demonstration and research farms and data.

LB925 achieves this through demonstration farms, voluntary partnerships with other agencies, and education.

LB 925 states intent to appropriate \$250,000 per year from FY 2023 to FY 2027. While it is unknown how much demand for these programs exists, we concur with DNR's assessment that should \$250,000 be appropriated the total amount will be expended. In addition, we concur with DNR's cost assessment for the program facilitator.

As all participation is voluntary, any costs incurred by other agencies and political subdivisions would be solely dependent upon participation.

# **Explanation of Estimate:**

The bill creates the Resilient Soils and Water Quality Act and intends appropriating the Department \$250,000 annually from FY22-23 to FY 26-27 for carrying out the purposes. The Act requires the Department to provide legal and technical assistance for creation of a "producer learning community" with specified statewide scope and structure to increase awareness and implementation of best practices for improving soil and water quality. The Act requires the Department to hire a facilitator to lead efforts for organizing the producer learning community and assisting the producer learning community in acquiring gifts, grants, and sponsorships. It is anticipated that this position would be centrally located and traveling 60-70% of the time to meet with producers, sponsors, and other stakeholders.

All expenditures will be used for administrative costs and operational costs. The Department is however unable to accurately estimate certain cost components such as for the Department making lease agreements or other payments or cost shares for demonstration/research farms or grants as identified in the bill. The nature of the market makes it difficult to estimate expenditures to establish lease agreements for demonstration/research farms or costs for potential fund-raising seed-money or promotional needs.

The required annual progress report to Governor and Legislative Committees and necessary legal and accounting functions will require Department staff and resources to support the learning community and new facilitator functions. The Department's estimated fiscal impact is the expenditures shown annually. There will be an increase for the new employees' base pay as well as health care expenditures which affects the fiscal impact for FY23-24.

No revenue is shown for either year for the reasons explained in the Technical Note.

## **Technical Note:**

The bill requires the Department to assist the producer learning community in acquiring gifts, grants, and sponsorships. This will require the producer learning community to organize as a legal private entity for the purpose of collecting and disseminating donations and for tax purposes and thus creates operational budget needs for the organization independent of the Department's administration. Unless a new State fund is created for such donations or some existing fund's criteria is amended, the Department will not have the necessary legal authority to administer donated funds of the producer learning community and may not receive donated funds for the community's purposes.
