LB228 repeals the aircraft and automobile guest liability statutes. Current state law provides that the owner or operator of any aircraft or motor vehicle is not liable for any damages to any passenger or person related to owner or operator who is riding in the aircraft or vehicle as a guest or by invitation except in the case of the pilot or driver being under the influence of alcohol or gross negligence of the owner or operator.

The University of Nebraska has indicated a likely increase in the cost of insurance. The amount of the increase in costs cannot be estimated.

The Department of Administrative Services Risk Manager has indicated that LB228 may limit the State's ability to recover funds for the State Workers' Compensation Fund and the State Insurance Fund in subrogation situations. The portion of recovery that may be lost cannot be estimated.
