LB 1204 amends the Nebraska Liquor Control Act. Under the bill, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission (NLCC) would be allowed to utilize electronic delivery for the licenses, warnings, etc.

Expenses for distributing paper licenses and posters are generally expended from NLCC's Rules and Regulation Cash Fund. NLCC estimates LB 1204 would reduce annual costs by approximately \$7,500. There is no basis to disagree with these estimates.
