Section 3 (7) requires additional information to be collected and entered into the Nebraska Criminal Justice Information System for each juvenile on probation or parole.

Depending on the sources of the data and the number of systems that need to be linked to for data pulls and page builds and updates in NCJIS ..... providing the name of the offender, the name of the probation officer, and the conditions of probation and parole for Adults on Probation or Parole and Juveniles on Probation or Parole would take several hours of development and re-design.

Cost estimates are \$150,000 (one time) .... \$75,000 for adult data and \$75,000 for juvenile data.
