Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB1143 amends §13-809 to require approval by the voters for the issuance of certain bonds under the Interlocal Cooperation Act & carries the emergency clause.

For all joint entities created on or after the effective date of this act that include a Nebraska school district or educational service unit (ESU), the entity cannot issue any bonds until the question of issuing the new bonds has been submitted to the voters of the school district & ESU that are a part of the entity at an election called for that purpose & within each such school district & ESU. A majority of the qualified electors voting on the question voted in favor of issuing the bonds.

Each school district & ESU will give notice of the election at least 50 days prior to the election. The question of issuing bonds may be submitted at the statewide primary or general election. The election will be conducted in accordance with the Election Act.

If the bond issues are defeated, they cannot be resubmitted for a period of 6 months from & after the date of the election.

There is no fiscal impact to the state but there may be impact to the school districts & ESU's when they're required to hold an election but that impact cannot be determined at this time.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 1143 requires any joint entity created after this bill is enacted involving a school district or educational service unit to get voter approval before issuing bonds.

Currently joint entities are not required to get voter approval to issue bonds. This change may make it harder for districts or ESU's to work together on joint projects going forward.

No fiscal impact to NDE or the State but there may be a fiscal cost to school districts or ESU's working together through a joint entity to get voter approval to issue bonds.
