LB 285 provides authority for the Director of Motor Vehicles to do all things necessary to comply with the federal REAL ID Act of 2005 and any regulations developed pursuant to the act. DMV indicates that regulations for the act may not be approved until the summer or fall of 2007. At that time, DMV will have a better idea of what will be expected of the state to comply with the act.

It is assumed the bill has no definite fiscal impact. However, costs for the state to comply with the federal REAL ID Act may be substantial in the future, depending upon final rules and regulations and timelines for compliance.
