Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 26 is the Rural Municipal Broadband Access Act.

Sections 2 and 3 provide definitions for the Act and Legislative findings that many rural municipalities lack access to quality broadband services and Internet services, despite significant private, local, state, and federal investment in broadband development. Specifically, "Municipality" means any city of the first class, city of the second class, or village.

Beginning January 1, 2024, a municipality may provide broadband services or Internet services on a retail or wholesale basis within the corporate limits and extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction if the municipality is located in an underserved area or unserved area and meets certain requirements.

The Public Service Commission estimates no fiscal impact. That estimate appears to be reasonable.

Municipalities, as defined in LB 26, may realize some fiscal impact. Due to the language allowing such services to be provided on a retail or wholesale basis, it is possible that some municipalities will realize a revenue increase. The amount of any such increase will be dependent on the cost to provide service and the amounts charged for service.

Requests for fiscal impact were sent to two such municipalities in the attempts to provide a sample of possible fiscal impact. No responses were received.
