Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

Starting with the 2024-25 school year, LB201 would change high school graduation requirements that would require high school students to fill out & submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form for federal financial aid for their postsecondary education.

A parent, legal guardian, or persons standing in loco parentis to the student can sign & submit the appropriate form prescribed by the Commissioner of Education indicating that the parent, legal guardian authorizes the student to decline to complete the FAFSA. A student who is nineteen years of age or older or is an emancipated minor can sign & submit the appropriate form.

The school principal or the school principal's designee of each public high school will provide the compliance information to the school district or governing authority for the high school & to the Nebraska Department of Education (NDE) without disclosing, for any student who has complied. A school principal or school principal's designee will also provide separately the aggregate number of students who have not complied.

On or before December 31, 2025, & on or before December 31 of each year thereafter, the Commissioner of Education will electronically submit a report with the information received by NDE to the Clerk of Legislature.

School districts may incur some minimal expenses implementing & maintaining this new requirement but the fiscal impact is unknown at this time.
