The Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education (CCPE) has estimated that of Nebraska Pell Grant-Eligible students, approximately \$166,000,000 in unmet need existed in 2021-22, to attend a Nebraska postsecondary educational institution. According to the CCPE, no additional administrative costs would be anticipated with this increase.
