LB603 amends §79-101 & §79-8,143 to changes provision relating to the Alternative Certification for Quality Teachers Act.

The Commissioner of Education will issue alternative certificates to teach on a full-time basis to any applicant that meets the following requirements:

- Possess a bachelor's degree
- Has successfully completed an alternative teacher certification program operated by an organization that satisfies the following criteria:
  - $\circ$   $\quad$  The organization operates in at least five states
  - o The organization has operated an alternative teacher certification program for at least ten years
  - The program requires candidates to pass a subject area exam & the pedagogy exam known as the professional teaching knowledge exam to receive a certificate under the program

A certificate issued only authorizes an individual to teach the subject & educational levels for which the individual has successfully completed an alternative teacher certification program. Issuance of an alternative certificate to teach will be subject to a criminal history record information check & payment of any required fees. An individual who receives an alternative certificate to teach will be subject to the same certification criteria as an individual who completes a traditional teacher preparation program if converting the alternative certificate to teach to a standard certificate to teach.
