Explanation of Estimate:

LB 649 changes provisions and penalties relating to arson, trespass, and graffiti. The bill could increase the number of persons in prison. The specific amount of impact is indeterminable.

As of 01/24/2023, 48 inmates among the NDCS population have a current arson conviction (.9% of the active inmate population). In the last five calendar years, the average number of admissions for arson was 16. In 2022, NDCS received 26 individuals convicted of arson.

As of December 2022, the average daily prison population (ADP) was 147% of design capacity. The FY22 per diem cost was \$28.38 for each inmate, or \$10,358.63 per year.
