Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 808 amends provisions of the Election Act.

Section 3 provides a definition for “Hand Count”.

LB 808 allows election commissioners or county clerks to conduct a hand count in place of vote counting devices and voting systems approved by the Secretary of State for tabulating votes cast at any election. Similarly, re-counts may be conducted by hand count. In situations where the apparent loser at a general election requests a hand counted re-count, the re-count shall be conducted by hand count.

The Secretary of State would need to promulgate rules and regulations regarding hand counting. In addition, training would need to be provided. Based on information from an election resource specializing in hand counting procedures and training, the Secretary of State estimates a cost of \$30,000. There is no basis to disagree with this estimate.
