LB796 amends duties under the Nebraska Public Transportation Act, requiring the Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) to develop and administer a safety oversight program. This program shall oversee rail transit systems operated by the state, an interstate agency, or any political subdivision.

NDOT has indicated no fiscal impact is expected as a result of LB796. They would likely hire a consultant to develop this program. Plus, they anticipate engaging the City of Omaha in a financial agreement, to commit funds for the consultant expense.

The safety oversight program in LB796 would apply to any rail transit system operated by the state, an interstate agency, or any political subdivision, as such the cost for the program could be the responsibility of NDOT. The overall fiscal impact of LB796 is indeterminate at this time.
