LB 286, as amended includes the provisions of LB 287. The bill appears to be a clean-up bill pertaining to motor vehicle titling and registrations. The changes appear to be clarifications of existing laws and changes to reflect actual practices.

The only provisions of the bill which may have a minimal fiscal impact are the sections allowing the issuance of personalized message plates for trailers, semi-trailers and trucks over ten tons registered at the county level. An increase in the issuance of personalized message plates increases revenue for the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund by \$30 for each set of plates issued. The fiscal impact is projected to be small and will depend upon the number of message plates issued for these types of vehicles.
