This bill allows for Nurse Aides to work for service providers under the Medicaid Comprehensive Developmental Disabilities Waiver under certain conditions. The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) anticipates a large increase in the number of Nurse Aides due to this provision. DHHS would require 1.0 FTE Administrative Technician starting October 1, 2024 to process the applications and perform other work. The additional staff person would be funded using a mix of General, Cash, and Federal Funds. There is no basis to disagree with this estimate of fiscal impact.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 982 allows a Nurse Aide to work for service providers under the Medicaid Comprehensive Developmental Disabilities Waiver if the specified conditions are met.

The Department of Health and Human Services would need to revise the existing regulations for 404 NAC 4, Certified Providers of Services and 175 NAC 3, Regulations Governing Centers for the Developmentally Disabled.

It is anticipated the number of Nurse Aides applying to be registered would increase drastically. The demand for their services would increase and Registered Nurse Aides typically earn a higher wage. Currently, there are over 33,000 active nurse aides on the registry. To remain active, the Nurse Aide must continue to be employed at an approved facility. DHHS must verify employment for each registrant on a rotating basis. DHHS employs 2.0 FTE Administrative Technicians to process applications, make verifications, and perform all other work associated with the Nurse Aide Registry. The current staff would not be able to handle additional workloads. Therefore, this estimate includes the costs to add 1.0 FTE Administrative Technician.

Existing staff would be utilized to revise regulations; update the website; and include service providers in the Nurse Aide Training Course which currently is only for facilities.

The cost impact of this work is being deferred from a formal request at this time and is estimated as follows:
