Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 994 proposes significant changes to the management and governance of Nebraska's Department of Correctional Services (NDCS). The Nebraska Legislature should assume general management, control, and governance of the Department, starting July 1, 2025. Additionally, the appointment of the Director of Correctional Services will be the responsibility of the Legislature. To ensure consistency with this act, the Judiciary Committee of the Legislature will be tasked with preparing amendments to align existing state laws accordingly.

Expenditures:

The Nebraska Department of Correctional Services (NDCS) indicates that the shift from the Executive to the Legislative Branch, as proposed, might lead to changes in the salary levels of protective services personnel and other staff. Additionally, further operational changes that the Legislature could implement within the NDCS may result in variations in the agency's revenue and expenditures. However, the precise fiscal impact of this bill remains indeterminable.

LB994 proposes legislative control and administration over all correctional institutions and the Department of Correctional Services, including the appointment and confirmation of the Director. Expenditure projections for 2025-2026 are uncertain due to the transfer of budget authority from NDCS to the Legislature.

The shift from operating under the Executive Branch to the Legislative Branch could change salary levels of protective services and other staff of the agency. Other changes the legislature might implement in operations of the NDCS could also increase or reduce revenue and expenditures of the agency.

The specific amount of fiscal impact of LB 994 is indeterminable.

Expenditure estimates are based on 2024-2025 budget numbers taken from the DAS-Budget website, which DCS submitted. These funds would need to be transferred under Legislature's authority. Without full operating knowledge of DCS, projecting the 2025-2026 expenditures would be inconclusive.
