LB1263 defines eligibility, requires the Department of Economic Development to create a program to provide a scholarship to any eligible student in Nebraska, requires the Department of Economic Development to promulgate rules and regulations for the program, and creates intent to appropriate \$1,000,000 in FY2024-25.

No basis to disagree with the administrative cost provided by the Department. Disagree with the aid amount as LB1263 creates an entitlement. For informational purposes our office is providing a baseline estimate using data from the Nebraska Department of Labor which indicates 4,236 potentially eligible applicants. The baseline cost would be \$10,590,000 per annum not including other eligible reimbursements which would include tuition and may include textbooks or tools. Our office lacks sufficient data to provide a more accurate estimate at this time.

**Explanation of Estimate:** 

LB1263 would create a scholarship program administered by DED. The scholarship would be for students enrolled in a trade program to learn a skilled trade. The program of study may be at a postsecondary educational institution or a private business. The scholarship includes \$2,500 plus tuition reimbursement for classes, supplies, or related expenses. DED would be required to promulgate rules and regulations to carry out the program.

The bill contains intent language to appropriate \$1 million for FY2024-25 to carry out the program.

DED estimates that the services of a DED Manager to award and pay the scholarships, and an IT Data/Database Analyst/Senior to track the awards through a grant management system.
