Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 1276 would make changes to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act regarding applications for a retail license, bottle club license, craft brewery license, or microdistillery license. Under the bill, in a city of the second class or a village, if the city or village clerk has been informed of a protest of the issuance of a proposed license prior to the applicant’s purchase of land for construction of the establishment for which a license is sought or purchase and renovation of an existing property, for such purpose, the city or village clerk could submit a request to the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission (NLCC) to waive the 45-day objection period and hold a hearing on the issuance of the license. The NLCC could hold a hearing on the license and could rule on the issuance or denial of the license on the basis of the applicant submitting any renovation building plans for the proposed licensed premises for the intended use as a licensed establishment under the Act and the other considerations required pursuant to section 53-132.

The NLCC estimates a potential for additional but rare hearings as a result of this bill. The NLCC believes it would absorb any of these potential costs. There is no basis to disagree with this estimate.
