LB 314 would expand the definition of water wells, and would define any excavation used to pump ground water for irrigation purposes as a water well. The Department of Natural Resources estimates that it may receive a small amount of cash fund revenue as a result of the registration of sand pits used for irrigation purposes. The agency estimate assumes 50 excavations per year may be subject to the \$40 registration fee, resulting in \$2,000 in cash fund revenue per year, beginning in FY08-09. It is estimated that the additional registrations could be processed by the Department within the existing agency budget.
