Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

The bill will be known as the Reimbursable Performance-Based Grants Act.

The bill states the purpose of the act is to provide property tax relief by reducing incarceration, poverty, and homelessness among young adults aged 18 to 25.

The bill outlines the creation of performance metrics for evaluating programs, including recidivism rates, poverty levels, employment, and homelessness statistics. The Department of Revenue will administer the grants, hire evaluators and financial analysts, and report annually on the program's effectiveness. If the initiative proves to save state money, the legislature intends to reinvest those savings into the grant fund to sustain and expand these efforts.

The State Treasurer's office states no fiscal impact from LB 70.

The fiscal office believes that there will be a fiscal impact on the Department of Revenue, as they will need to hire additional staff to complete the duties outlined in LB 70. The amount of the impact is indeterminate at this time.

The bill states intent to transfer an amount equal to the savings relating to correctional and social services generated by awarding grants to a newly created cash fund for the purpose of awarding grants. Initial grants would need to be funded by the General Fund as no savings would be calculated until initial grants have yielded any such savings.
