LB 193 allows the State Department of Education (NDE) to designate a special authorization upon submission of a proposal by at least one teacher education program. The teacher education program must show evidence of public interest in the special authorization that is less than the level needed to warrant the development of a full endorsement. The special authorization is not a certificate or permit and must meet certain course and credit hour criteria identified in the bill.

The bill has no fiscal impact for NDE to approve a preparation program. Increased expenditures will only occur if the demand for the special authorization is such that there is the need for an endorsement at some time in the future. The University and state colleges indicate the bill has no fiscal impact in terms of course offerings. The state colleges indicate existing courses will be the basis for the special authorization.
