Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 51 adopts the National Crime Prevention and Privacy Compact, enabling the Nebraska State Patrol (NSP) to oversee the secure interstate exchange of criminal history records for noncriminal justice purposes while maintaining compliance with state laws on privacy and public access.

NSP states that by joining the compact in this proposal, can eliminate the \$13.25 FBI fee per applicant, saving approximately \$178,200 in Fiscal Year 2026 and \$356,400 in Fiscal Year 2027. The agency states that while this won't completely prevent future applicant fee increases, it will help minimize them as the Criminal Identification Unit works to address its operating deficit and depleting Cash Fund reserves.

The Supreme Court has indicated that LB 51 would have no fiscal impact.
