The bill requires increase of the Department's budget and spending authority by \$500,000. The bill expresses an intent to appropriate \$500,000 from the General Fund for FY2025-2026 to the Department for the purposes of issuing a grant to a natural resources district that has more than two hundred fifty watershed structures to fund projects involving the operation, maintenance, or repair of such structures for projects with a total cost exceeding thirty thousand dollars per structure.
