LB464 addresses organized retail crime by establishing clear legal definitions, prohibitions, and tiered penalties based on the value of stolen merchandise—ranging from a Class I misdemeanor for thefts of \$500 to \$1,499, to a Class IIA felony for thefts of \$5,000 or more, with enhanced penalties for repeat offenders.

The Supreme Court has stated that LB 464 will have a minimal fiscal impact and will not require any additional resources.
