Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 92 is the Residential Tenant Clean Slate Act.

The bill aims to seal eviction records in specific situations like dismissed cases, reversed judgments, pandemic-related nonpayment, minor defendants, or regulatory violations, and after three years for eligible cases. It ensures tenants won't face discrimination or have sealed records considered in housing or job applications, giving them a fresh start. The act goes into effect on January 1, 2026, with the State Court Administrator handling the implementation.

The Supreme Court states that LB92 will impact the workload of judicial and court staff, as well as the JUSTICE case management system, with the clean slate and sealing procedure requiring additional time from court staff and judges. Although the extent of the workload increase is unclear, the JUSTICE system cannot be fully reprogrammed to implement LB92 as written, and preliminary modifications for FY25-26 are estimated to cost at least \$40,000 in Cash Funds.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB92 will have an impact on judicial and court staff workload and JUSTICE, the court case management system. The extent to which workload will be increased cannot be determined at this time, but the clean slate and sealing procedure will take additional time for court staff and judges. JUSTICE cannot be reprogrammed to fully implement LB92 as currently written. However, a preliminary FY25-26 estimate to modify JUSTICE is \$40,000 minimum, General Funds.

Note. This fiscal note may be amended at a later date if the Judicial Branch is able to receive more information regarding how LB175 would be implemented.
