It sets guidelines for courts to follow during this transfer, ensures juveniles have rights like counsel and protections regarding statements made during psychological evaluations, and includes a process for quick appeals to keep cases moving efficiently.

The Supreme Court has stated that LB 407 will have a minimal fiscal impact and will not require any additional resources.
