The definition of Formula Students is updated from sixty percent to one hundred percent of the qualified early childhood education for Fall Membership & Average Daily Membership (ADM) calculations.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Nebraska Department of Education estimates that the shift from 0.6 to 1.0 FTEs for qualified early childhood students within Formula Students will result in an increase in the TEEOSA calculation of approximately \$2,900,000.
