This policy will include:

- integrated student supports representing a school-based approach to promoting a student's well-being by providing & coordinating services for students & their families that target academic & nonacademic barriers to educational & life success
- extended learning time opportunities before & after a typical school day, & over summer vacation & other breaks, & augment
 the learning opportunities offered during the traditional school day & year
- collaborative leadership practices that engage stakeholders with different types of experiences & expertise, including parents, students, teachers, principals, & community partners in working together & sharing decisions & responsibilities toward a commonly held vision or outcome for the school
- authentic family engagement that encompasses a broad array of interactions among parents, students, educators, & community members that fall along a spectrum in which families & community members exercise varying degrees of power within the schools.
