LB 291 would eliminate one citizen member from the Nebraska Environmental Trust Board and change the geographical districts that the remaining eight members represent. As the terms of current members expire they would be replaced with individuals that reside in the new districts. Board members are appointed for six year terms.

The estimated annual savings once the citizen membership on the board is reduced to eight is \$2,000 cash funds for meals, lodging and mileage.
