LB557 amends several sections to:

- provide, change, & eliminate definitions
- change provisions relating to the enrollment option program, student fees, student transportation, focus schools, focus
 programs, & magnet schools, net option funding under the Tax Equity and Educational Opportunities Support Act (TEEOSA),
 the learning community coordinating council, diversity plans for each learning community, & certification of student qualifying
 for free or reduced-price lunches
- provide funding to students denied option enrollment
- eliminate provisions relating to open enrollment option students & diversity plans

For FY2023-24, there were 24,672 students that were approved for the enrollment option program & 971 students were denied.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There would also be the costs of the educational support payments made to the students, but that amount cannot be determined at this time. The education support payments for the 971 students denied in FY2023-24, is estimated to be \$2,427,500.

Enrollment option students are a factor in the calculation of the Tax Equity & Educational Opportunities Support Act (TEEOSA) but those costs cannot be determined at this time.

The Nebraska Department of Education (NDE) estimates that there would be costs for the administrating the educational support payments, but that amount cannot be determined at this time.

School districts would have additional significant expenses related to facilities and staffing as districts can no longer deny enrollment options which could create significant building/staffing capacity situations.
