LB104 would eliminate various existing procedural requirements associated with first class city annexation proposals. If the bill were to be enacted, first class cities proposing annexations may avoid certain costs associated with existing annexation procedural requirements that would be eliminated, particularly costs associated with adoption of a plan for extending city services to land proposed to be annexed and public notice costs for publishing annexation resolutions and maps of land proposed to be annexed. Any related impacts of the bill would be dependent upon the extent to which governing bodies of affected municipalities face consideration of annexation proposals.
