This bill would change sheriff's fees and handgun certificate fees. The bill has the emergency clause.

It appears that this bill will not have a fiscal impact to the state. The Supreme Court estimates no fiscal impact.

IMPACT ON POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS: The Douglas County Sheriff's Office estimates that the increase in the various fees in this bill (civil process, criminal, and handgun permit) will have the following revenue impact:

Applying the Douglas County Sheriff's Office estimate on a per capita basis to the rest of the state, then the remaining counties could see a fee revenue increase of almost \$3 million. This estimate was performed by the Legislative Fiscal Office analyst (LFO), and it is meant to estimate what the increased fee revenue impact may be to the rest of the counties.
