LB 50 redefines a motor vehicle for purposes of the motor vehicle licensing board act. A motor vehicle is defined to also mean any engine, transmission or rear axle, regardless of whether it is attached to a chassis, that is manufactured to be installed in a vehicle weighing more than 16,000 pounds for which a title is required as a condition to registration.

The Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board indicates the bill will increase the number of manufacturers licensed by the board. An estimated five additional licensees will generate \$2,000 of annual cash fund revenue for the board.
