LB 150 repeals the Nebraska Prostitution Intervention and Treatment Act. The legislation, LB 1086, passed in 2006, provided for the Legislature to appropriate funds to create a coordinated program of education and treatment for individuals that participate in prostitution-related activities. The A bill appropriated \$750,000 of general funds in 2006-07 and \$750,000 of general funds in 2007-08 to the Department of Health and Human Services Finance and Support as state aid to be used for intervention and treatment.

The Governor vetoed LB 1086A, so no funding has been provided for the act. Since funding has not been provided, the repeal of the act has no fiscal impact.
