LB 372 changes the penalty for the disclosure of a digital image or digital signature from a motor vehicle operator's license. Persons who are currently convicted are guilty of a Class IV felony and subject to removal from office or discharge. Persons guilty of releasing such information after the bill passes will be guilty of a Class I misdemeanor.

The change in the penalty may result in decreased fines received pursuant to misdemeanor versus felony convictions and/or decreased incarcerations. A decrease in fines reduces revenue received by counties which accrues to the public schools. The fiscal impact is unknown.
