LB 109 defines low-speed vehicles and authorizes the use of such vehicles. The bill provides that low-speed vehicles shall not be operated on any controlled-access highway with more than two marked traffic lanes. The Department of Roads indicates that passage of the bill will require the department to change signs posted on controlled-access highways. The estimated one-time expense for 240 signs is \$20,000 of cash funds from the Roads Operations Cash Fund.
