LB 175 changes provisions relating to payments for lost license plates for vehicles reported as stolen. The bill provides that a fee for a set of new license plates will not be assessed if a vehicle or trailer was reported stolen under section 60-178. Refunds of licensing fees for stolen vehicles shall not be reduced for a lost plate charge. Credits of licensing fees paid on stolen vehicles may be reduced for a lost plate charge but applicants shall not be required to pay the plate fee for new plates.

The bill may have a minimal fiscal impact in terms of decreased revenue for the Highway Trust Fund due to the elimination of plate fees in instances where vehicles or trailers have been stolen.
