LB207 would provide express authority to the Department of Administrative Services – State Building Division to lease state property to a private entity to provide services necessary for state operations or for the convenience of state officers and employees when the space is not needed for public use. To the extent that space in state properties administered by State Building Division is fully occupied/leased, the authority granted by the bill represents no fiscal impact. To the extent that space in state properties administered by State Building Division are currently unoccupied/unleased, lease revenue and direct costs associated with space occupancy could increase if any currently unoccupied space were to be leased to private entities under authority to be granted by the bill.
