LB842 would amend Chapter 19 of Nebraska statutes to allow cities of the first class (population of 5,000-99,999), cities of the second class (population of 800-4,999) and villages (population of 100-799) to enter into contract agreements with people, firms, corporations, or political subdivisions to:

- Operate, maintain, manage, and enforce municipal parking facilities including:
 - On-street metered parking;
 - Off-street public lots; or
 - Public garages.
- Permit through the contract or agreement for the issuance of parking citations, fine collection, equipment maintenance, and the operation of payment system

The cities of the first class, cities of the second class, and villages would:

- Keep control of the parking facilities ensuring they operate in the interest of the public;
- Set or approve all parking rates, charges, and fines;
- Not enter into any contract agreement more than 30 years long (if a city of the first class); and
- Not enter into any contract agreement for over 10 years of durations (if a city of the second class or village).

This bill would become effective three calendar months after the adjournment of the Legislature.

There would be no fiscal impact to the state.

The City of Kearney has indicated no fiscal impact.

Note: This fiscal note will be revised if additional responses are received which would change the fiscal impact to the state.
