LB 767 amends statute regarding cities of the first and second class.

It raises the cost floor of projects from \$30,000 to \$90,000 which require:

- approval of the city council before moving forward,
- a competitive bidding process, and
- advertisement for bid.

For municipal electric utilities with annual revenue in excess of a million dollars, this is required for projects over \$180,000.

For municipal electric utilities with annual revenue in excess of five million dollars, this is required for projects over \$250,000.

For municipal electric utilities with annual revenue in excess of ten million dollars, this is required for projects over \$300,000.

For municipal electric utilities with annual revenue in excess of twenty million dollars, this is required for projects over \$500,000.

For municipal electric utilities with annual revenue in excess of thirty million dollars, this is required for projects over \$750,000.

For municipal electric utilities with annual revenue in excess of seventy-five million dollars, this is required for projects over \$1,000,000.

No Fiscal Impact to the state. The bill could result in decreased administrative costs for cities. That impact is indeterminate.
