Explanation of Estimate:

LB1057 would revise the definition of adult day service in the Health Care Facility Licensure Act to clarify that adult day services exclude community-based waiver services provided by entities certified under the Developmental Disabilities (DD) Services Act or as a Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) center, thereby exempting those programs from being treated as adult day health providers subject to healthcare facility licensure requirements.

This bill would eliminate duplicative adult day health licensure requirements for DD-certified agencies that are already subject to comprehensive state oversight and quality assurance standards. The bill allows DD-certified providers to offer adult day services at existing DD day center locations without obtaining additional licensure under the Health Care Facility Licensure Act. Regulatory oversight and participant protections remain in place through the DD service system.

The Health Care Facility Licensure Unit would need to review currently licensed adult day service providers to determine eligibility for the exclusion and develop and implement a communication plan. Coordination with the Division of Developmental Disabilities may be necessary.

There may be a minimal loss of revenue if any currently licensed providers qualify for the exemption and choose to discontinue licensure. There are currently twenty-one licensed adult day service providers. Initial and annual licensure fees range from \$200 to \$300, depending on capacity.
