LB 1064 creates the Large Load Customer Regulation Act.

It requires public power suppliers to establish standards regarding large load customers. These standards establish:

- requirements of disclosure from large load customers;
- a flat study fee of at least \$100,000 for initial transmission screening studies;
- expectations of site controls; and
- financial commitment requirements.

The bill allows public power suppliers to negotiate rates and to impose requirements of large load customers.

It requires public power suppliers to develop procedures to ensure flexibility with large load customers to ensure appropriate emergency responses.
