LB841 amends §79-1139 & §79-1164 to require special education services, to require parental consent, & to assign the burden of proof & the burden of production for certain hearings.

Each school district will provide special education services to each student that has been identified & verified in the student's individualized education program.

No school district will implement a change to an individualized education program without consent from the student's parent, legal guardian, educational decisionmaker, or surrogate unless:

- the school district documents reasonable efforts to obtain that consent & no response is received from the student's parent, legal guardian, educational decisionmaker, or surrogate within ten calendar days following those efforts
- the school district obtains approval to implement such change through a hearing. The school district will be responsible for the burden of proof & the burden of production

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Nebraska Department of Education (NDE) estimates the average cost of the Special Education due process hearings over the last three years to be approximately \$39,365 per year. With the increase of hearings due to LB841, NDE estimates that the annual costs of those hearings will increase to between \$157,000 & \$196,000 annually.

The Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) estimates the costs of the hearings to be between \$79,000 to \$118,000 annually.

There could be additional expense at the district level to meet the provisions of LB841, but those expenses cannot be determined at this time.

Explanation of Estimate:

NDE anticipates an increase in the number of due process hearings, and the associated costs with those hearings. Each due process hearing involves the cost of hearing officer and preparation of transcripts of the proceedings.

Over the last three calendar years, NDE expended an average of \$39,365 per year for special education due process hearings. The NDE estimates an annual increase in costs between \$157,000 to \$196,000 for additional hearings brought about by LB841.

Additional costs will be incurred by school districts, but the NDE does not have data to calculate those costs.
