LB915 would increase the cap of inland port districts which may be designated in the state from five to six. LB156 (2021) created transfers of \$5,000,000 in FY22-23 and another transfer of \$5,000,000 in FY23-24 from the General Fund to the Site and Building Development Fund for the purpose of making awards to Inland Port Districts which qualify under the act. All funds for the purpose of aid for inland port districts have been awarded and no future funding source is identified. No fiscal impact.
