LB 1090 would require petition circulators to file a notarized affidavit with the Secretary of State to verify they are not convicted felons. The bill also provides a penalty for falsifying information.

The Secretary of State anticipates the bill would cause a significant amount of additional filings to be processed which would require an additional full-time Elections Specialist to be hired by October 2026 before the bill becomes effective on January 1, 2027. The Elections Specialist would oversee the affidavit process and requirements, review new affidavits, scan and catalog the affidavits for use as public records or in the case of litigation, follow-up with individuals and organizations regarding their requests, respond to questions or omissions in the affidavits, compare affidavits to petition pages during signature verification, and prepare documentation regarding the process. The estimate provided includes the salary, benefits, supplies, and related technology for one full-time Elections Specialist and is adjusted in fiscal year 2026-2027 based on the potential hiring date.

The Supreme Court estimated minimal impact not requiring additional resources to provide judicial education.

**Explanation of Estimate:**

LB1090 requires all petition circulators to file a notarized affidavit with our office attesting that they are qualified. It is anticipated that this would likely be a significant amount of additional filings that would be processed by our office, in addition to the time needed to respond to questions and concerns related to the new requirement. Our elections division does not currently have the resources available for this additional staff time and as such we would need one (1) additional full-time Elections Specialist specifically devoted to this new requirement. This person will oversee the affidavit process and requirements, review new affidavits, scan and catalog the affidavits for use as public records or in the case of litigation, follow-up with individuals and organizations regarding their requests, respond to questions or omissions in the affidavits, compare affidavits to petition pages during signature verification, and prepare documentation regarding the process. We anticipate needing to hire this new employee by October 2026 in order to ensure the processes are in place when the bill is effective on January 1, 2027 (as such, FY2027 costs would not be for a full fiscal year, but FY2028 costs and ongoing would be expected to be around \$80,000 for salaries, benefits, supplies, and related technology costs).
